- I will ensure a minimum 50% of playing time for all team players.
- I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging for all my players.
- I will maintain the highest standards of personal conduct and lead by example in demonstrating "Fair Play" and sportsmanship to all my players.
- I will provide a sports environment for my team that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and I will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
- I will be knowledgeable in the rules of soccer, and I will teach these rules to my players.
- I will use those coaching techniques appropriate for all of the skills that I teach.
- I will remember that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for children and not adults.
- I will always show respect for the opposing team's coaches, players, spectators and especially the referees. I will not argue or question any calls made at the games or try to stop or disrupt the game in any way.
