Please note the following requirements:

Complete the 20011/2012 Indoor Registration form - 2 pages fully filled in with the player's information, parent's information and signed where applicable. The second page is mandatory per the Ontario Soccer Association.

Volunteering to be a Coach, Assistant Coach, Manager

Complete the "House League Coach" Please note that the "Police Check" must be fully filled in. All documents are on the website under documents section. (The CUSC will process the "Police Check" free of charge and can not pay for any Police Checks done by an individual.)

Post Dated Cheques

Cheques should not be post dated, and if they are your application will only be processed the date of the post dated cheque and your space will not be guaranteed to be still available.

New Members of Cumberland United

If the child is new to the club, include photo copy of Birth Certificate, Passport, or an official document clearly showing child's name and birth date.

Uniforms

If the child requires a new uniform, they can be purchased at the clubhouse. Please ensure you check the website under about us tab to see when equipment section is open. Please note that a FULL CUSC Uniform is required to play in this league. (This means you must have both a Blue and White CUSC soccer Shirt, Blue CUSC shorts and CUSC socks.) Players will be granted a two week grace period and after that cannot play without correct uniform.

The current price list which was updated as of October 7, 2010 is as follows for all sizes:

Shirt - \$16 each Shorts - \$11 each Socks - \$6 each

Note - that both a blue and white shirt is required for all players.

FINAL NOTE:

- You only need to submit the last 2 registration pages which are numbered page 1 of 2 and page 2 of 2. You do not need to include the first two pages of instructions.

ALL PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES HAS ITS RISKS: I participate in the game of soccer because it is physically and mentally challenging. In consideration of my participation in such programs, activities and events, I hereby acknowledge that I am aware of the risks and hazards associated with or related to this activity. The risks and hazards include, but are not limited to: Injuries from executing strenuous and demanding physical techniques in soccer; Injuries from dry land training including weights, running, and massage; Injuries from grass, turf and other surfaces including bacterial infections and rashes; Injuries resulting from falls to the ground due to uneven or irregular terrain or surfaces; Injuries from collisions with walls and soccer equipment; linjuries resulting from failure to properly use any piece of equipment or from the mechanical failure of any piece of equipment; Spinal cord injuries which may render me permanently paralyzed; Injuries from extreme weather conditions which may result in heatstroke, sunstroke or hypothermia; Injuries from contact, colliding or being struck by other participants, spectators, equipment or vehicles; injuries resulting from vigorous physical exertion and strenuous cardiovascular workouts; Injuries from exerting and stretching various muscle groups; and travel to and from competitive events and associated non-competitive events which are an integral part of the organization's activities.

Furthermore, I am aware: That injuries sustained in soccer can be severe; That I may experience anxiety while challenging myself during the activities; That I may come into close contact with other participants, including the possibility of accidental and unexpected contact; That my risk of injury is reduced if I follow all rules established for participation; and That my risk of injury increases as I become fatigued.

I AGREE TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MYSELF: I am participating voluntarily in these activities, events and programs. I agree that there are risks in soccer as described above. By participating voluntarily in these events, activities and programs, I am exposed to these risks and hazards. I agree to accept them and be responsible for any injury or other loss which I might receive while participating in these events, activities and programs. If something happens to me, I release the organizers of responsibility for any claims, demands, actions and costs which might arise out of my participation. In this Agreement I understand "organizers" to mean: The Ontario Soccer Association, District Associations, Leagues, Clubs and their directors, officers, members, employees, volunteers, officials, participants, clubs, agents, sponsors, owners/operators of facilities, and representatives.
