NEW Community Coaching Courses

The Canadian Soccer Association has now completed work on the Community Stream for the NEW PROGRAM

For the first transition period both old and new soccer coach training will be recognized. After a certain Date (which CSA will announce) the old CCC, CCY and CCS certification levels will not be recognized. (CSA / NCCP to provide more info on the transition)

To clarify, if you are coaching female players who turn 11 in 2012 (born in 2001) or male players who turn 12 in 2012 (born in 2000) and you do not have your senior diploma, you will need to complete Soccer for Life and MED.

The CUSC will reimburse the costs of the course upon submitting proof of successful completion of the course and receipt of funds paid. (NOTE: You must be a coach for the CUSC throughout the 2012 outdoor season to receive a refund)

NOW THIS IS THE REALLY IMPORTANT PART: As soon as you have decided to apply for any course, make arrangements to get the cheque (PAYABLE TO CUMERLAND SOCCER) to the office at 680 Taylor Creek Unit #5. (There is an exterior mail box which is open 7x24)

Payment must be received at the CUSC office by Friday April 15, 2012 in order to hold your spot. We have people waiting to take these courses.

CUSC office is located at 860 Taylor Creek, Unit # 5, Orleans, Ontario K1C 1T1 and the office hours are on the website.

If your payment is not received by April 15, 2012 and I have someone waiting they will get your spot and you may lose yours. We must pay the OSA for a minimum of spots and this means we will not hold spots for people who have not paid in time.
