EXHIBITION GAMES – REQUEST FOR REFEREES

- Requests for exhibition games will be considered from CUSC coaches for games being played on CUSC fields (including Louis Riel Dome).
 - Exceptions will be entertained for games being played at other venues such as Gloucester Dome (Hornets Nest), Ottawa University Field, Carleton University Field. Games played on fields belonging to other leagues should be arranged with that particular league
- All requests should be addressed to the Club's Head Referee via e-mail using headreferee@cumberlandsoccer.com at least two (2) weeks before the intended date. Requests should specify the age group and if competitive teams are involved, they should also identify whether the teams are Div1, Premier or Regional.
- Premier and Regional Teams playing 11 aside normally require Assistant Referees. Therefore, the request should also specify if Assistant Referees are required.
- Field arrangements are to be requested separately. These requests should be addressed to the CUSC Facilities Director via e-mail using facilitiesdirector@cumberlandsoccer.com.
- Games will be subject to the same rules and sanctions of regular season games.
- Payment for referees will be the responsibility of the Coaches and amounts will be in accordance to the published fees for the specific age groups and which are posted on the CUSC website under the Referee section of the CUSC website <http://www.cumberlandsoccer.com/>. Payment will be made directly to the officials by the coaches at the field and just prior to the game.

Note:

In the event that you have made prior arrangements with a particular referee that is known to you, you should nevertheless advise the Head Referee via e-mail in order to verify that the particular individual has a valid and current license and is qualified for that particular age group.
